Qualifications

Candidates should have demonstrated leadership abilities and strong administrative experience in an academic, library, or comparable setting; experience in donor cultivation and stewardship; and a documented record of excellence in scholarly activity, commensurate with tenure. The successful candidate will be appointed as a tenured faculty member in the College of Liberal Arts. A demonstrated ability to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels is required. This position will be expected to teach at least one course each semester, which is the teaching load for tenured faculty members serving as Director. Field of expertise will determine the faculty member's home department. Expected start date is Fall 2016.
