

The Italian Ministry of University has opened a call for a three-years contract (that can be renewed for further 3 years) for young researchers - both Italians and international scholars - who have get their PhD in the last six years and have been working in research and/or teaching in an academic institution out of Italy for the last three years. The position offered should be paid with a monthly net salary around 1500-1700 euro per month.

The Department of Architecture and Planning at the Polytechnic of Milan is interested in hosting a young researcher who can get the grant offered by the Italian Ministry. We are interested in a young scholar with sociological background, working in the fields of urban policies with special focus on social welfare, social inequalities and immigration. This person would be involved in the research activities of the Research Laboratory of Social Policy (http://www.diap.polimi.it/ricerca/scheda_lab.php?id=58), directed by prof. Costanzo Ranci

This structure is currently carrying out research on social cohesion in global cities in Europe, new forms of social risks and vulnerability emerging in post-industrial societies, the crisis of the middle class in urban contexts. The position includes both research and teaching activities (in English).

The deadline for the call of the Ministry of University is the 29th of January.

In order to apply candidates have to prepare a research project and to send two reference letters.
