ReMapRisk Lima: Mapping for Action

cLIMA sin Riesgo developed an online platform called ReMapRisk to enable systematic monitoring of who is affected by how and why. The tool allows local dwellers in the historic centre and periphery of metropolitan Lima to document and more time at various scales. The tool is open to public enquiries and produces maps in response to each enquiry at the scale of household. The data helps to visualise the spatial distribution of risk mitigation investments, which can be used to plan future and to evaluate their impact.

ReMapRisk enables the production and sharing of community-based data about the experiences, vulnerabilities and capacities. With the support of the observatories (Observatory of the Peripheries of Lima hosted by [CENCA](#); the Observatory of the Historic Centre hosted by [CIDAP](#); and the Metropolitan Lima Observatory hosted by [Foro Ciudades para la Vida](#), local dwellers are able to report on events as they happen in their neighbourhoods.
