Position Description:

We are seeking a recognized academic to become a full professor of "Tourism Economy and Digital Transformation" in the relevant courses at the European Campus Rottal-Inn.

The ideal candidate is required to have a degree in economics, IT or media sciences with broad skills in business administration and digital business. Extensive expertise of the tourism industry, economics in the context of tourism, e-tourism, digital media, digital transformation or digitization in tourism and a high affinity for numbers and technical problems are required.

Successful candidates are required to constructively interact with students and colleagues, enriching the campus through research and teaching activities to potentially inspire a broad spectrum of people. Expertise in the required field should be documented, among other things, in scientific publications. National and international industrial experience, coupled with a highly motivated desire to share this experience, complete the ideal profile.

The successful candidate is expected to participate in the further development of existing study programmes as well as in the establishment of new study programmes. For these challenges, a tourism lab, where experiments can be performed and emotional experiences recorded is available. This will support the creation of therapeutic landscapes or emotional branding research and thereby contribute to the touristic profile of the European Campus. Due to the international orientation of the campus, all lectures are held exclusively in English.

Potential colleagues at the European Campus have international experience and intercultural backgrounds. The workplace is located directly on campus.

The position is scheduled to begin in March 2019.

Some work at the main campus in Deggendorf may be required.

Required Qualifications, Knowledge & Experience:

- ▶ A university degree
- ▶ An aptitude for scientific work, usually proven by a PhD qualification
- ▶ Pedagogic skills
- ▶ Outstanding accomplishments in the implementation or development of research results during a minimum of five years professional experience. This must have been acquired after graduation with at least three of the five years outside the higher education sector. In some cases, proof of non-academic professional work may be acceptable when a significant part of this work involved the cooperation between the higher education sector and a non-academic body over a minimum of five years.

Salary:

The salary is in accordance with the Bavarian salary law as W-2 professorship. In addition, the university offers individual research and educational bonuses and performance remuneration (so-called "Leistungsbezüge") for further achievements.
