About the job

The Department of Geography is advertising a full-time permanent position for Associate Professor in human geography of globalization and sustainable development. The thematic focus for the position is global inequalities with reference to sustainability and social and environmental justice. We are looking for candidates with solid research experience and enthusiasm for research-led teaching and communication across the society-science spectrum of geography and sustainable development.

The associate professor is expected to contribute actively to the research environment at the department. This includes running research projects, initiating new research activities, recruiting PhD candidates as well as contributing to the collective efforts of developing research groups and strategic fields of engagement.

The Department of Geography runs several national and international educational programmes, and the associate professor will engage in teaching and supervision of both undergraduate and graduate students in different areas of specialization. The Department is also engaged in research and education collaborations with universities in the Global South. The successful candidate will engage with these partnerships and the academic and societal dialogues on global North-South relations that they inspire. Research and teaching experience as well as involvements in international networks spanning global divides will therefore be given significant weight in the assessment of candidates. We will give preference to candidates whose interests complement and strengthen the current profile of the Department.

The position reports to Head of Department.

Required qualifications

You must have the qualifications required for the position of associate professor in the field of Human Geography, as outlined in the regulations concerning appointment and promotion to teaching and research posts

Your ph.d. should be within the discipline of Geography. Candidates within comparable relevant fields of studies who have contributed actively to the discipline of Geography may also be considered.

If you can document that you are in the final stages of your ph.d., your application may be considered.

You must be able to show progression in teaching and research within the position's thematic focus.

In the assessment, publications from the last five years (excluding parental and other care leaves) will be given special weight.

Good written and oral English.

You must document relevant basic competence in teaching and supervision at a university/higher education-level, as referenced in the Norwegian national Regulations. If this cannot be documented, you will be required to complete an approved course in university pedagogy within two years of commencement. NTNU offers qualifying courses.

New employees who do not speak a Scandinavian language by appointment is required, within three years, to demonstrate skills in Norwegian or another Scandinavian language equivalent to level three of the course for Norwegian for speakers of other languages at the Department of Language and Literature at NTNU.
