The successful applicant will be expected to begin on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019. Salary, benefits, and leave policies will be competitive at an international level. Yale-NUS College is committed to supporting faculty research through grants, travel allowances and study leaves.

Applications should comprise the following: a cover letter explaining why the position at Yale-NUS is of interest; a full *curriculum vitae*, including all publications; statements on research interests, teaching experience and teaching philosophy, and; names and contact details of at least three referees. Tenure-track applicants must also include three academic references with their application.
