Carbon Emissions Are Already Falling in 30 Cities

Since nations signed on to the Paris Agreement four years ago, committing to collectively lower carbon emissions to below 2 degrees Celsius, progress across the globe has been uneven and, sometimes, even discouraging...ccording to a new analysis published by a coalition of cities known as C40, ahead of its annual World Mayors Summit in Copenhagen. The latest news is an update to C40's 2018 analysis, which identified a handful of cities across the global north that have hit their "peak" emissions before 2015, meaning they have since reduced their greenhouse gas emissions by at least 10 percent.
