Funded M.S. Graduate Research Opportunity in Tourism Management

Dr. Bynum Boley within the Parks, Recreation and Tourism Management (PRTM) program at the University of Georgia is pleased to announce a funded 2-year Graduate Research **Assistantship leading to a Master's of Science (M.S.)** degree starting in January 2020. The M.S. student will be working closely with Dr. Bynum Boley on a United States Army Corps of Engineering (USACE) project examining preferences for coastal tourism experiences in San Juan, Puerto Rico, Charleston, South Carolina and Miami, Florida. Primary duties of the graduate student will be managing and collecting primary data, data entry, data analysis, presenting research at conferences and co-authoring peer-reviewed publications.

Qualifications: Prospective applicants should have a minimum GPA of 3.0 for their B.S. degree and a combined verbal and quantitative GRE equal to or greater than 300. For international applicants, they must have a minimum TOEFL score of 80 with at least 20 on speaking and writing. Applicants should also have solid analytical and writing skills.

Stipend and Benefits: \$20,951/year plus a full tuition waiver and supplemented health insurance. This assistantship is based on a 40% stipend 16-hour work week. The student will have to pay activity fees (approximately \$1,170/semester) to the University of Georgia.

Starting Date: The starting date for the assistantship is January 7, 2020.
